



What is the Council?

The Council was created in July 2002 by State Statute 26.02 to advise the governor, legislature, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Commerce, and other state agencies on a host of forestry issues in the state

It's made up of a diverse group of leaders in the forestry community who are appointed by the Governor

- (a) The protection of forests from fire, insects, and disease.
- (b) The practice of sustainable forestry, as defined in s. 28.04 (1) (e).
- (c) Reforestation and forestry genetics.
- (d) Management and protection of urban forests.
- (e) Increasing the public's knowledge and awareness of forestry issues.
- (f) Forestry research.
- (g) Increasing the economic development of the forestry industry and employment in the forestry industry.
- (h) Marketing and use of forest products.
- (i) Legislation that impacts on the management of forest lands in this state.
- (j)Staffing and funding needs for forestry programs conducted by the state.
